Skipper Atharv Deshpande stepped up with an unconquered 71-ball 55 (2x4) but he ran out of partners in 40th over as Poorna Vikasa was bowled out for 161. Janana Prabhu led the bowling attack for The Sports School with figures of 4 for 32. Shreyas Indian and Tanshh Krishna took two wickets apiece. In reply, The Sports School
